What is Futsal? Futsal is a variant of soccer that is played on a smaller playing surface and mainly played indoors. Futsal is played between two teams of five players, one of whom is the goalkeeper. Unlike some other forms of indoor soccer, the game is played on a hard court surface delimited by lines rather than walls. Futsal is also played with a smaller ball with less bounce than a regulation soccer ball. The rules create an emphasis on improvisation, creativity and technique as well as ball control and passing in small spaces.
